"Golda was a young Jewish girl living in Germany during the Nazi horror. Her father, mother, brother and sister perished in the Holocaust. Golda herself escaped only because she was the last one in line to be herded into the gas chamber at Maidenak, but the guards could not squeeze her in. so they pulled her out and slammed the steel door shut. She was the only survivor. When Maidenak was liberated, all Golda wanted was to, somehow, some way, avenge the death of her family. 'But it struck me,' Golda said, 'that I would be no better than Hitler himself.' So Golda went to work in a hospital for children in the town of Maidenak. She said that she had deliberately chosen to help German children – most of them victims of the war like herself – to purge her bitterness toward the German people. And she would remain in Maidenak until she had completely forgiven Hitler. 'When I can do that, then I am allowed to leave.'"
