Position: Children and Youth Minister

General Summary

The ministry leader position will be an opportunity for an individual to learn about and lead ministry and Sunday School with children, youth and young adults and/or families. Through this ministry leadership the individual will research, plan and lead new programming with the target population.

Qualifications

- The ministry leader should be a growing person of faith who enjoys working with children, youth and young adults.
- The ministry leader should have developed people skills and be able to work effectively with children, youth and parents.
- The ministry leader should be entrepreneurial and open to learning and developing new skills.

Scope of Responsibility

- The ministry leader will work directly with the target population in planning, organizing and leading the activities of ministry.
- The ministry leader will make contact with children, youth and parents about ministry needs, specific events/programs, projects and objectives.
- The ministry leader will generate ideas, be entrepreneurial and self-starting, prepare for events/programs, lead and/or train/resource others to lead activities, teaching others and additional ministry responsibilities as agreed upon with the Director of Congregational Care and Connection.

Supervision and Compensation

- The ministry leader will team with and be mentored by the Director of Congregational Care and Connection.
- Work an average of 8 - 10/hours per week, flexible schedule.
- Work for a monthly stipend of \$500.
