Position: Ministry Intern Serving Children & Youth

General Summary

The ministry intern position will be an opportunity for an individual to learn about and lead ministry with children and youth and/or families. Through this internship the individual will research, plan and lead new programming with the target populations.

Qualifications

- The intern should be a growing person of faith who enjoys working with children and youth.
- The intern should have developed people skills and be able to work effectively with children, youth and parents.
- The intern should be entrepreneurial and open to learning and

developing new skills. **Scope of Responsibility**

- The intern will work directly with the target population in planning, organizing and leading the activities of ministry.
- The intern will make contact with children, youth and parents about ministry needs, specific events/programs, projects and objectives.
- The intern will generate ideas, be entrepreneurial and self-starting, prepare for events/programs, lead and/or train/resource others to lead activities, teaching others and additional ministry responsibilities as agreed upon with the Director of Congregational Care and Connection.

Supervision and Compensation

- The ministry intern will team with and be mentored by the Director of Congregational Care and Connection.
- Work an average of 8 - 10/hours per week, flexible schedule.
- Work for a monthly stipend of \$500.
